Across the variety of competitions, youngsters will converse, recite, sing and play musical instruments to attract the attention of the adjudicators and win a prize on the Friday.

Senior competitors will take to the stage on Saturday and, as the Mull Mòd takes place just a few weeks before the National Mòd, competitors will be looking for that final critique to polish their performances. Competitors travel from around the country from Caithness in the north to Edinburgh in the south to compete and we are fortunate enough to have 8 Senior Choirs attending this year.

The Mull Provincial Mòd will also play host to a new exhibition from the National Piping Centre - 'Noting the Tradition' - an oral history project on Piping over the past 50 years.

If you haven't visited the Mull Provincial Mòd before, it is well worth the trip! We are looking forward to meeting old friends and welcoming new ones.

In addition to looking after the stall Tom and Rae had the opportunity to attend "Orain nam Pìobairean", with Breabach, Kathleen MacInnes and Friends and the able Fear an Taigh, Calum Ross. This event was on the Wednesday evening in the National Piping Centre.

Eisteddfod

GENEDLAETHOL CYMRU



Chaidh aon de na Fèisean is ainmeil anns an t-saoghal, an Eisteddfod Nàiseanta, a chumail eadar an 4mh agus an 11mh den Lùnastal anns a' Chuimrigh. Bha rudeigin ann a chòrdadh ris a h-uile duine – ceòl, dannsa, ealan, tachartasan teaghlaich agus mòran eile.

'Se àite sònraichte a th' anns a' 'Phàillean Phinc' ann an sgìre na 'Maes', far am bidh na prìomh fharpaisean agus seirbheisean cultarail a' gabhail àite. Tha ceudan de thachartasan eile a' gabhail àite thairis air an t-seachdain air feadh na sgìre, le suas gu 300 bùird, tha mòran ri cheannach agus tha rudeigin ann dhan a h-uile duine.

'B ann an 1892 a chaidh am Mòd Nàiseanta a stèidheachadh, as dèidh turas a rinn riochdairean bhon Chomunn Gàidhealach don Eisteddfod. Tha an Eisteddfod uamhasach taiceil dhan Mhòd agus tha An Comunn taingeil airson an ceangal a tha eadar an dà bhuidheann.

'B e Seumas Greumach agus Iain Moireasdan na riochdairean Albannach a bha an làthair aig an Eisteddfod am bliadhna agus abair gun deach fàilte chridheil a chur air an dithis aca fhad's a bha iad ann. Thuirt Iain Moireasdan "Thairis air na 30 bliadhna chaidh seachad tha cànan na Cuimrigh air na h-aon duilgheadasan fhulang 's a tha a' Ghàidhlig a' fulang an dràsta. Fhuair iad seachad air na duilgheadasan sin agus tha iad ann an suideachadh an-diugh nach saoiladh iad o chionn ginealach air ais. Tha Cardiff mu 10 mìle air falbh bho far an deach Eisteddfod 2012 a chumail. Tha 24 Sgoiltean ann an Cardiff a' teagasg tromheadhan na Cuimris. Tha mòran phàrantan ann a tha a' cur an cuid chloinne do na sgoiltean seo, ged nach eil an cànan aca fhèin, ach tha iad a' toirt taic dhan chànan mar seo.

Tha e misneachail gu bheil iad air a dhol bho suidheachadh làn mì-chinnt gu suideachadh cho fallain ri seo, agus tha e comasach dhuinn ann an Alba, an aon rud a choileanadh.

The National Eisteddfod, one of the world's great festivals, was held from 4-11 August at the old Llandow airfield near Cowbridge, in the Vale of Glamorgan, Wales. Music, dance, visual arts, original performances, family activities – there is something for everyone at the National Eisteddfod.

The Pink Pavilion is the focal point of the 'Maes', where the official competing and main cultural ceremonies are held, but there's hundreds of other activities all over the Maes throughout the week, and with up to 300 stalls and trade stands, it's a shopper's paradise, with gifts of all kinds to suit every pocket.

The National Mòd was founded in 1892 after a delegation from An Comunn Gàidhealach visited the Eisteddfod and undertook to set up a festival along similar lines in Scotland. A debt of gratitude is due to the Eisteddfod and the Welsh festival is, to this day, a strong supporter of the National Mòd.

James Graham and John Morrison attended the Eisteddfod as the representatives of Scotland and were met with goodwill and kindness during the visit. Both representatives were delighted with the reception they received and the goodwill that they encountered. John Morrison noted that "all of the issues that the Gaelic language faces at the moment have confronted the Welsh language over the last thirty years. They have overcome the challenges and are now in a situation that they could not have imagined a generation ago. Cardiff was less than 10 miles from the 2012 Eisteddfod and the city of Cardiff now boasts 24 Welsh Medium Primary Schools. Many of the children who attend these schools have parents who do not speak Welsh but who have committed to the language through the children. It is hugely encouraging that they have moved from a situation of uncertainty to one of hope and it is possible for us to achieve a similar outcome in Scotland."
