With approximately 650 individual competitors taking part in over 50 competitions it appears that the Gaelic language and culture is in safe hands with the standard that was apparent among competitors. This was the first Lewis Mod to be held since a re-organisation in the schools estate on the island and competitor numbers have been very encouraging.

Mod convener Amy MacAulay said: "This was once again a very good Mod. We are very impressed with the levels of fluency among the children and particularly with how strong the local dialects remain. It shows the sterling work that is going on in all our schools in the islands and among the parents."

A new non-competitive event for P1-4 Choirs featured as part of this year's Mod programme, which saw a number of schools perform in the Town Hall to a packed and very appreciative audience.
