#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- Entries Competitors in all sections of the Syllabus should enter their names and full addresses with the Secretary not later than 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2012.
- Competitors in the Junior Section must be within the prescribed age group for each class on 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2012. All Junior Competitors must when entering give exact date of birth.
- Competitors may enter for more than one competition. No competitor may sing as his/her own choice any song that is prescribed in the Mod Syllabus. No competitor may sing the same song in more than one competition.
- Competitors are not allowed to consult books or copies of prescribed pieces during competitions.
- All spoken and sung matter must be in Gaelic, and competitors using translations from the English or from any other language will be disqualified.
- Junior Solo Singers are limited to 20 lines. Senior Solo Singers are limited to 28 lines.
- 7. The Adjudicators may at any time call upon a competitor to cease reading, reciting, narrating or singing. In all cases, the decision of the Adjudicators will be final and they reserve the right to withhold prizes or trophies.
- Pianoforte accompaniments are not allowed, except in competition 55a. Competitors in Instrumental Section must choose their own tunes and hand music to judges when about to compete.
  - N.B. Name of Gaelic Air must be stated on entry form.
- Choir numbers, Junior Choirs: minimum number of voices 8, maximum 26;
   Senior mixed: minimum 16, maximum 30; Choirs and Quartettes must sing not less than 3 verses.
- Trophies must be returned inscribed and in a clean condition to the Mod Office on day of competitions. If desired, cost of inscription will be refunded.
- Video, audio recording, use of cameras, mobile phones are prohibited during competitions.
- The Committee will not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to entries or personal property.
- 13. The following must be made available by the competitor to the Secretary by 30<sup>th</sup> April 2012: Own choice solo competitions - 1 copy of music and words plus translation. Choirs, duets, quartettes: 4 copies of music and words plus 2 copies of translation. (Relevant documents may be sent by Email. N.B. Print copies are not returnable).
- 14. After performances, competitors shall await adjudications and any presentation ceremonies. If this is not possible, a representative should be appointed to act on their behalf.
