GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

- Competitors in the Junior Section must be within the prescribed age group on 1st October of the current year, to comply with National Mod requirements. Dates of birth must be provided with Junior entries and will be checked. (Any competitor over 18 years of age on the 1st October of the current year is eligible for Senior Competitions, providing entry qualifications are met.)
- 2 Date of entry and special conditions are as stated in the Syllabus. Late entries will not be accepted.
- Where songs are **not** prescribed, two copies (words and music) <u>one with English translation</u>, should accompany the entry and must be received by **24**th **April.** <u>Points will be deducted for non-compliance.</u>
- 4 All competitions are Open.
- 5 Songs are to be sung without accompaniment, except in Competitions 49, 60, 61 and 113.
- 6 Solo singers may be asked to sing two verses only, or two verses with chorus.
- In Competitions 29 40 and 45 competitors may sing as their own choice the National Mod Syllabus prescribed songs for these age groups. In Competitions 41 & 42 competitors should **not** choose songs prescribed for this year's National Mod.
- 8 Competitors should be ready to appear when called. Please inform a Steward at the venue if this is not possible.
- 9 Competitors are not allowed to consult books or music during competitions. Exceptionally, this rule does not apply to Instrumental Competitions.
- In the INSTRUMENTAL section **Beginners** are competitors with less than **two years** playing experience. In Competitions 62 & 66 a **Novice** should be of up to **one year's** experience and Novice competitions may be entered **only once**.
- 11 Competing in any of the piping competitions will automatically exclude a competitor from taking part in chanter competitions. A **Novice** may not enter any other piping or chanter competitions.
- In all competitions, the decision of the adjudicators is final
- No prize will be awarded in any competition in which the standard of performance is adjudged to be unsatisfactory
- The number of prizes may be reduced to ONE in the case of any competition in which the number of competitors is less than FOUR.
- Pendants will not be awarded more than once to any competitor, and <u>may</u> not be awarded in any year when fewer than THREE eligible singers perform
- All Cups and Shields must be signed for at the Mod and are retained by the winners for one year. They should be cleaned and returned to Furan not later than **22nd May**.
- Rules and age groups in the Local Mod may differ from that of the Royal National Mod. Competitors should check with An Comunn if entering the National Mod.
- The **entry fees** per competition are as follows: **Solo** £1.00

Duet £2.00 Group £5.00

Choir £5.00 and should accompany the completed entry form The maximum amount to be paid per child for solos/duets - £3.00
