CATEGORIES ARE SPLIT BY **PRIMARY CLASS** (Primary 1, 2, 3 etc.) and **SECONDARY AGE** (11-12, 13-15, 16-18) AS PER ROYAL NATIONAL MÒD. PLEASE NOTE THIS IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE DEPENDING ON NUMBER OF ENTRIES

If a child is being educated through the medium of Gaelic and will be in Primary 2 or above at the time of the Royal National Mòd, he/she must be entered into fluent competitions. Children in Gaelic Medium Education in P1 should enter learner competitions. However, children in P1 who come from a fluent background (whether in GME school or not) i.e. when at least one or both of the parents/carers speak Gaelic in the home, should be entered into fluent competitions.
