Thuir Seumas Greumach, Àrd Oifigear a' Chomuinn, "Ri linn a' choròna-bhìorais, 's e bliadhna air leth mì-àbhaisteach a th' air a bhith ann do thachartasan ealain, leithid Am Mòd Nàiseanta Rìoghail. Cha robhar an dùil idir gum bithear a' cumail thachartasan air loidhne seach ann an da-rìribh. Le sin a ràdh, 's e cothrom eile a th' ann a bhith a' taisbeanadh nan ealain Gàidhlig dhan mhòr-shluaigh a dh' aindeoin nan dùbhlain a tha romhainn an-dràsta."

## VIRTUAL ROYAL NATIONAL MÒD'S ENTRY CLOSING DATE EXTENDED

Time is running out for participants to submit their performances for The Virtual Royal National Mòd which will be held online this year. However, An Comunn Gàidhealach have announced that the entry deadline will now be extended to the **21st August**, meaning that participants wishing to take part at this year's Mòd now have extra time to register their submissions.

Seonag, Mòd Officer, said, "With children now returning to schools in early August, we especially want to give schools more time to enter and take part in this year's Mòd, so participants now have an extended period, until the 21st August to enter. We're delighted with the effort people have gone to with their submissions so far, across the range of art-forms. The extended date for submissions now gives schools and pupils the extra opportunity to take part."

James Graham, Chief Executive of An Comunn said, "It's been a difficult year for the Arts and festivals like our own this year due to the COVID-19 pandemic. None of us imagined that we would be holding our events online this year but being able to do so allows us to showcase the Gaelic Arts despite the current situation."



### WHAT ARE THE RULES?

- There are not too many rules involved to be able to participate in the Virtual Mòd.
- With the exception of literary submissions, participants do not have to submit own choice words or music.
- Participants should upload a copy of their performance by - **Friday 21st August 2020.**
- Fluent speakers must enter fluent categories and learners must enter learner categories.
- Participants in junior categories must be within the specified age group on the 1st of October 2020.
- Any participant under 18 years is not eligible for Senior categories.
- A participant should not enter in both Junior and Senior categories.

## CIAMAR A BHIOS FIOS AGAM AM BU CHÒIR DHOMH FARPAISEAN FHILEANTAICH NO LUCHD-IONNSACHAIDH INNTRIGEADH?

- A thaobh fharpaisean òigridh, ma tha pàiste ga oideachadh tro mheadhan na Gàidhlig agus ann am Clas 4 no nas àirde aig àm a' Mhòid Air-loidhne san Dàmhair, feumaidh e/i com-pàirteachadh ann am farpaisean nam fileantach.
- A thaobh fharpaisean inbhich, bu chòir do chom-pàirtichean an ùghdarras a chleachdadh agus co-dhùnadh a bheil iad fileanta sa chànan no nach eil, mus inntrig iad na farpaisean buntainneach.
- Faodaidh an dà chuid farpaisich fhileanta agus ionnsachaidh com-pàirteachadh ann am farpaisean fosgailte.

## DÈ NA RIAGHAILTEAN A THA AN LÙIB CLUICH IONNSRAMAID, MA THA MI AIRSON COM-PÀIRTEACHADH?

- Bidh com-pàirteachadh ann an aon sam bith de na farpaisean Pìobaireachd gu fèin-ghluasadach a' toirmeasg com-pàirt ann am farpaisean Feadain.
- Bu chòir do chom-pàirtichean dèanamh cinnteach gu bheil am Fonn Mall aca à tùs Gàidhlig. Far am feum ceòl a bhith 'de thùs Gàidhlig', tha seo a' ciallachadh **fonn òran Gàidhlig, no fonn dannsa no fonn mall bhon traidisean Ghàidhlig.**

## HOW DO I KNOW IF I SHOULD ENTER FLUENT OR LEARNER CATEGORIES?

- For junior categories, if a child is being educated through the medium of Gaelic, and will be in Primary 4, or above, at the time of the Virtual Mòd in October, he/she must be entered into Fluent categories.
- For senior categories, participants should use their discretion and determine whether they are fluent in the language or not before entering respective categories.
- Open categories are open to both fluent and learner participants.

## WHAT ARE THE RULES IF I PLAY AN INSTRUMENT AND WANT TO PARTICIPATE?

- Participation in any of the piping categories will automatically exclude a participant from taking part in the Chanter categories.
- Participants should ensure that their Slow Air is of Gaelic origin. Where music is required to be 'of Gaelic origin' this will mean that it should be the **melody of a Gaelic song, or a dance tune or slow air from the Gaelic tradition.**

- Tha na cuibhreachaidhean làithreach ga dhèanamh doirbh do bhuidhnean a thighinn còmhla gu pearsanta.
- Ach, tha sinn mothachail gu bheil daoine anabarrach cruthachail a thaobh a bhith a' cruthachadh ceòl air-loidhne, agus mun àm a bhios am Mòd Air-loidhne a' gabhail àite san Dàmhair, dh'fhaodadh gum bi e comasach gnìomhaidhean buidhne a cheadachadh.
- Ged nach eil roinnean sònraichte air an eagrachadh a thaobh Còisirean, Càraidean, Còmhlain no Buidhnean Ionnsramaideach, bhiomaid air leth toilichte nam biodh e comasach do bhuidhnean gnìomhaidhean a chur a-steach, a ghabhadh an taisbeanadh aig a' Mhòd Air-loidhne.

## WHAT ARE THE RULES FOR LITERARY AND ART CATEGORIES?

- All literary submissions must be the entrant's original, uncorrected work.
- All work must be typewritten and should be submitted in Microsoft Word format.

## WHAT ABOUT CHOIRS, GROUPS AND DUETS?

- Current restrictions make it difficult for groups to come together in person.
- However, we are aware that people are being incredibly creative in terms of creating music online and by the time the Virtual Mòd takes place in October restrictions may allow group performances to take place.
- Although there are no specific categories for Choirs, Duets, Folk Groups, or Instrumental Groups, we would be delighted if groups are able to submit performances which could be showcased during the Virtual Mòd.

- Bidh sinn a' buileachadh theisteanasan a' Mhòid Air-loidhne airson gnìomhaidhean 'Anabharrach', 'Àrd-Mholta' agus 'Ionmholta'.

### DE MURA H-EIL MI AIRSON MO GHNÌOMHADH A THAISBEANADH AIR MEADHANAN SÒISEALTA AIG A' MHÒD AIR-LOIDHNE?

- Tha sinn airson a bhith comasach air ur gnìomhaidhean a roinn agus saidhbhreas ar cànan 's ar cultair a thaisbeanadh tron Mhòd Air-loidhne san Dàmhair 2020. Ach, tha sinn a' tuigsinn mura bi sibh deònach ur gnìomhadh a thaisbeanadh.
- Faodaidh com-pàirtichean cead a dhiùltadh do an gnìomhadh a bhith air a thaisbeanadh rè a' Mhòid Air-loidhne, tron roghainn ro-aonta a thaghadh aig àm innteartan a chur a-steach air-loidhne.
- Ma thaghas com-pàirtichean an roghainn ro-aonta aig an ìre seo, chan fhoillsichear an gnìomhadh agus cha bhi e taisbeante aig a' Mhòd Air-loidhne.

### WILL I RECEIVE AN ADJUDICATION FOR MY PERFORMANCE?

- Performances will be assessed by an independent panel who will award 'Exceptional', 'Highly Commended' and 'Commended' performances. There will be no marks or scores awarded.
- Performances will be showcased on An Comunn Gàidhealach's social media platforms during the Virtual Mòd.

### WILL PRIZES BE AWARDED FOR PERFORMANCES?

- Due to logistical challenges and current restrictions, we are unable to hand out trophies or medals this year.
- We will be awarding Virtual Mòd certificates to 'Exceptional', 'Highly Commended' and 'Commended' performances.

### WHAT IF I DON'T WANT MY PERFORMANCE TO BE SHOWCASED ON SOCIAL MEDIA DURING VIRTUAL MÒD WEEK?

- We want to be able to share your performances and showcase the richness of our language and culture during the Virtual Mòd in October 2020. However, we understand if you do not wish your performance to be shown.
- Participants may refuse consent for their performance to be shown during the Virtual Mòd by choosing the opt-out option at the time of submitting their entries online.
- If participants opt-out at this stage, their performance will remain undisclosed and will not be showcased during the Virtual Mòd.

## BÀRD A' CHOMUINN SANDAIDH NICDHÒMHNAILL JONES

Tha mi toilichte innse dhuibh gu bheil planaichean a' tighinn air adhart gu math airson sreath de thachartasan, anns am bi mi an sàs mar Bàrd a' Chomuinn Ghàidealach sna mìosan a tha romhainn. Tòisichidh sinn le còmhradh eadar Meg Bateman agus mi fhìn air 18 Lùnastal, agus nas fhaide air adhart, còmhraidhean le bàird eile, tron 'Mhòd air-loidhne' san Dàmhair, agus Seachdain Leabhraichean na h-Alba san t-Samhain. Barrachd fiosrachaidh air làrach-lìn A' Chomuinn Ghàidhealaich, agus air na meadhanan sòisealta, a dh'aithghearr!

Tron àm 'fo ghlas', tha mi cuideachd air a bhith trang ag obair gus crìoch a chuir air an ath chruinneachadh bàrdachd agam. Bhithinn an còmhnaidh air mo bheò-ghlacadh, chan ann a-mhàin le dòighean-labhairt sònraichte agus cleas-fhacail ann am bàrdachd; ach cuideachd le cruth agus cumadh: rannachadh, ruitheam, meataireachd, cuideam, pàtran-loidhnichean sa rann, agus feartan leithid uaithe, uaim agus amus. Tha mi anabarrach deidheil air òrain, agus 's e òrain a th'ann an cuid de na dàin anns a' chruinneachadh ùr agam - coltach ris a' cruinneachadh roimhe 'Crotal Ruadh'; agus leis a sin, tha iad air an sgrìobhadh le meataireachd agus rannachadh de iomadach seòrsa.

Mar sin dheth, smaoinich mi, san chòlhbh agam air a mhìos seo, moladh agus meòrachadh no dhà a thairgse dhuibh air leabhraichean mu chruthgan-bàrdachd a chòrd rium gu sònraichte, agus a bha feumail dhomh airson an dà chuid: barrachd roghainn, 'meud is leud' a lorg na mo chuid sgrìobhaidh fhìn; agus meòrachadh agus luach a chur air na dàin a sgrìobh bàird eile. Thoiribh mathanas dhomhsa, le sin, mas e liosta caran fada de stòran agus tobaran a th'aig bonn a' chuilbh air a mhìos-sa!

Dhuibhse aig a bheil ùidh nas doimhne anns a 'chuspair seo, mholainn fhìn dìreach: thoiribh ruith gu farsaing ann an raon de leabhraichean Gàidhlig, agus bithibh gu sunndach 'uile-itheach'! Mar eisimpleir, bidh an ro-ràdh ann an cuid de na cruinneachaidhean sa liosta agam gu h-ìosal a' dèiligeach le cruthan-bàrdachd gu coitcheann, mar phàirt de bheachdachadh air na bàird, am bàrdachd, an àmman agus beatha. Ach, ann an iomadach ro-ràdh eile, gheibh sibh earrann air leth air cruthan-bàrdachd; bidh àireamhan-dhuilleagan (ann am camagan) a' toirt iomradh air na h-earrannan a' dhèiligeas gu sònraichte ri cruthan-bàrdachd.

Gheibh sibh liosta nan cruinneachaidhean Ghàidhlig ann an dà roinn - cruinneachaidhean thar ùine; agus cruinneachaidhean mu linntean mu seach. San dàrna roinn seo, tha còig leabhraichean sònraichte math; mu bhàrdachd nam meadhan-aoisean, agus an 17mh, 18mh, 19mh agus 20mh linn fa leth.

Gheibh sibh cuideachd taghadh de thrì leabhraichean (ann am Beurla) air cruthan-bàrdachd a-mhàin; le John Hollander; Mark Strand agus Eavan Boland; agus Stephen Fry. Tha gach fear, nan dòigh fhèin, a' tabhann 'tacsonamaidh' farsaing de chruthan-bàrdachd, (m.e. sonaid, rondeau, lethrann gaisgeil, ealaidh), le eisimpleirean de gach cruth sònraichte (sgrìobhte leis na h-ùghdaran fhèin, agus / no le bàird bho dhiofar amannan). Tha mi an dòchas gum faigh sibh tlachd às na trì leabhraichean seo; tha iad cruthachail, eirmseach, tarraingeach - agus fiù's 'risqué'!

A bharrachd air na leabhraichean seo, tha tòrr artaigilean ann cuideachd, ann an irisean acadaimigeach, òraidean, agus pàipearan cho-labhairtean mar 'an sreath dà-bhliadhna' 'Rannsachadh na Gàidhlig'. Fhuair mi lorg o chionn ghoirid air artaigil le Andrew Philip. Bidh e a' tairgse iomradh air sgeamaichean rannachaidh, ruithim agus beum na bàrdachd Ghàidhlig; agus an uairsin a' tabhann meas àlainn mun dàn 'Aotromachd' le Meg Bateman, a' gabhail a-steach na pàtranan tarraingeach chonsonain a chleachdas Meg, mar fheart a bharrachd air sgeama nan rann.

Anns a' chiad leabhar san liosta gu h-ìosal, 'Bàrdachd Ghàidhlig' le Watson, tha ro-ràdh farsaing (còrr is 30 duilleag, t-d. xxxiii - lxi) air cruthan bàrdachd Ghàidhlig. Tha iomadh bàrd agus sgrìobhadair eile, a rèir na leugh agus na chuala mise, cuideachd dhen bheachd, mar a tha mi fhìn, gu bheil an ro-ràdh cumhachdach aig Watson fhathast na thaisbeanadh iomachumseach air a' chuspair seo - ceud bliadhna às deidh dhan leabhar nochdadh.

Tha mi an dòchas gum faigh sibh brosnachadh an seo gus barrachd a leughadh mu dheidhinn bàrdachd. Tha mi an dòchas cuideachd gu bheil sibh uile a' cumail sàbhailte agus fallain, agus 's dòcha a' faighinn cothroman gus coinneachadh a-rithist le teaghlach agus càirdean - leis an lasachadh beag dhen ghlasadh a th'againn. Tha mi a' sgrìobhadh a' chuilbh seo thugaibh ann an Uibhist a Deas. Nach mise tha toilichte a bhith air ais dhachaigh. Seo agaibh dol fodha na grèine an seo, sealladh cho math dhomh!

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## BÀRD A' CHOMUINN SANDAIDH NICDHÒMHNAILL JONES

I am pleased to say that plans are coming along well for a series of events in which I will be involved as Bàrd a' Chomuinn Ghàidealach in the months ahead. The first will be a conversation with Meg Bateman on 18 August, followed by events with other bards during the Virtual Mòd in October and at Book Week Scotland in November. More details on the An Comunn Gàidhealach website and social media soon!

During lockdown I have also been hard at work completing my next collection of poetry. I have always been fascinated not only with poetry's unique ways of communicating, expression and playing with words; but also with its forms and shapes: rhyme schemes, rhythm, metre, stress, numbers of lines per verse, and features like alliteration and assonance. This is in part because of my love of song. As with my previous collection, 'Crotal Ruadh - Red Lichen', a number of the poems in the new collection are intended as songs, and therefore written with deliberately chosen (but varying) rhyme schemes and metric patterns.

So I thought I would offer you, this month, some reflections and suggestions on books about poetic form which I have particularly enjoyed, and found useful, both for experimenting in my own writing and expanding my range of options; and in analyzing and appreciating the poetry written by others. So please forgive me for a rather lengthy list of sources at the bottom of this column this month!

For those with a deeper interest in this subject, I personally recommend browsing widely in a range of Gaelic books, in a cheerfully omnivorous way. For example, the forewords of some of the anthologies which I cite in the sources list below discuss structure as part of a consideration of the poets, their poetry and the times in which they lived. Other forewords contain a separate section on poetic forms per se; page numbers (in parentheses) after these book-listings refer to the sections of the forewords that deal specifically with poetic form.

I have listed the Gaelic anthologies in two sections - collections over time; and collections devoted to specific centuries. There are five very fine such volumes in the latter category, covering the Medieval period, and the 17th, 18th, 19th and 20th centuries, respectively.

I also offer a selection of three books in English on poetic form, by John Hollander; Mark Strand and Eavan Boland; and Stephen Fry. All three, each in their own way, offer a wide-ranging taxonomy of existing poetic forms (e.g. sonnet, rondeau, heroic couplets, ode), accompanied by examples of poems in each particular form, either by the

authors themselves, and/or by established poets from various eras. In my view, all three books make thoroughly enjoyable reading, and are often inventive, witty, entertaining - or even downright risqué!

In addition there are many fine articles, either in academic journals, transcripts of lectures, or proceedings of conferences such as 'the biennial 'Rannsachadh na Gàidhlig' series. To give one example, I recently found an article by Andrew Philip. He makes some observations on Gaelic rhyme, metre and stress patterns, before offering a lovely appreciation of the poem 'Aotromachd' by Meg Bateman, with her use of attractive patterns of consonantal clustering as an additional feature to the rhyme scheme.

The first book I cite in the list below, Watson's 'Bàrdachd Ghàidhlig', has an extensive introduction including over 30 pages (pp. xxxiii - lxiv) on metres and measures. I am not alone in holding the opinion that this section of Watson's Introduction is still amongst the most thorough and authoritative presentations on the subject of poetic structure, a hundred years after its first edition.

I do hope you find something of interest to read more about poetry here. And I also hope you are all keeping safe and well and enjoying the slight easing of lockdown and opportunity to see family and friends. I am writing this column to you from South Uist. I am so pleased to be back home. Here's our sunset, such a welcome sight to me! Warm good wishes as ever. Sandy

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

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
