



# COMPETITION SYLLABUS JUNIOR



**KEY:** **Open** - Open to Fluent and Learner **Mixed** - Open to Boys and Girls

The version of the melody provided on prescribed sheet music should be sung as written but the rhythms of the notes can be sung taking account of Gaelic stresses and local dialect variations.

**NEW:** If a child is being educated through the medium of Gaelic, and will be in Primary 2, or above, at the time of the Royal National Mòd, he/she must be entered into fluent competitions. Children in GME (Gaelic Medium Education) in P1 should enter learner competitions. However, children from P1 who come from a fluent background (whether in GME school or not) i.e. when at least one or both of the parents/guardians speak Gaelic in the home, children should be entered into fluent competitions. Please refer to the 'Guidelines for Families, Schools and Tutors' document for more information. Parents/guardians or teachers of a child with additional support needs (or an exceptional circumstance) and looking to enter a child into different competition, should contact the An Comunn Gàidhealach office. Parents/guardians should use their discretion when entering their child/children into competitions.

Chanter/Bagpipes - Competition Rules: (to be read in conjunction with the Royal National Mod Competition Rules)

1. This is a competition open to Junior players aged 18yrs and under who have not competed in any adult Bagpipe competition.
2. Competitors must be within the prescribed age group on the first day of October of the year in which the Mòd is held.
3. Competitors in events P01 and P02 are not eligible for other events.
4. Competitors in event P03 are not eligible for other events other than P07 subject to age qualification.
5. Competitors entering event P08 cannot also compete in P07.
6. Competitors who have performed a full Piobaireachd in any competition cannot compete in event P07.
7. Competitors may only enter events in their own age group.
8. Competitors must be prepared to present themselves in the order of play as specified in the programme, or as directed by the Stewards. Failure to do so may mean disqualification.
