GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1. All Competitions are Open.
- 2. In all Competitions, the decision of the adjudicator is final.
- 3. Competitors are required to be ready to appear when called or to inform Stewards at venue if not possible.
- 4. Songs are to be sung without accompaniment, except in Competitions 49, 60, 61 and 110.
- 5. Solo singers may be asked to sing two verses only, or two verses with chorus.
- 6. In Competitors 29 40 and 45 competitors may sing as their own choice the National Mòd Syllabus prescribed songs for these age groups. In Competitions 41 and 42 competitors should not choose songs prescribed for this year's National Mòd.
- 7. Competitors are not allowed to consult books or music during competitions. Exceptionally, this rule does not apply to Instrumental Competitions.
- 8. Where songs are not prescribed, two copies (of words and music) one with English translation, should accompany the entry. Music must be handed in by 22nd April 2023 otherwise marks will be deducted.
- 9. No prize will be awarded in any competition in which the standard of performance is adjudged to be unsatisfactory.
- 10. The number of prizes may be reduced to ONE in the case of any Competition in which the number of competitors is less than FOUR.
- 11. Pendants will not be awarded more than once to any competitor, and it will be at the discretion of the adjudicators that they will be awarded in any year when fewer than THREE eligible singers perform.
- 12. All Cup and Shields are retained by the winners for one year and must be cleaned and returned to Furan not later than 20th May.
- 13. Date of entry and special conditions are as stated in the Syllabus.
