Sing waulking songs of own choice. Any number of songs may be sung, which, may, but not necessarily, include an 'òran basaidh', within a time limit of 10 minutes. Groups must consist of at least 7 persons, with one, or more soloists, if preferred. The singing will be in unison. Any variations to unison singing should be strictly in accordance with local traditional approaches to the singing of waulking songs. Spoken input as part of the performance, or preceding the singing of another song, is also at the discretion of the group.

Competitors should ensure that their own choice music is of Scottish Gaelic origin. This is defined as the melody of a Scottish Gaelic song, or a dance tune or slow air from the Scottish Gaelic tradition, and in the Scottish Gaelic idiom.
